French Creek?

French Creek is nationally recognized as the most biologically diverse stream in the northeastern United States. The Creek contains species that once inhabited the entire Ohio River drainage but now remains only in French Creek.

In fact, the twelve hundred square mile watershed in Western New York and Pennsylvania provides refuge to 98 rare or endangered species of plants and animals.

Area residents take pride in knowing that French Creek is a special place.
