The Village of Sherman's Downtown Market Analysis performed by Camoin Associates, Inc. is ready for review and comment. The purpose of this Community Planning Grant funded by CDBG was to select three properties for potential reuse or redevelopment and draft concept plans.

The study involved members of the Steering Committee, area businesses, Main Street property owners, investors, realtors, and research compiled by Camoin. The in-depth feasibility and viability study identifies area market conditions of Sherman, Chautauqua County, along the I-86 corridor with the goal of drawing interest from real estate agents, developers, and investors to the Village for economic development.

Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvement Project broke ground in March 2022 with an expected completion date of May 2023. This project involves several new processes including UV treatment, screw press dewatering, variable speed blowers, and the sequencing batch reactors (SBRs).



The **Drinking Water Improvement Project**. This project will be wrapping up this spring. It includes the renovation of the water wells, pumps, and buildings that supply the reservoir from the lower aquifer. Also it will involve the final service connections and shutting down the old mains. J.D. Northrup Construction and its subcontractor(s) will be reclaiming yards as weather permits.

The **NY Main Street - Technical Assistance** grant in the amount of \$20,000 from the NY Office of Community Renewal, along w/ an additional investment from the Village of Sherman, was used to contract architects from the Clinton Brown Co. to perform the building condition surveys to help prepare Main Street businesses seek rehabilitation as well as improvement grant opportunities. The Downtown Feasibility Study will be available to the public to view after April 20th, at www.shermanny.org
