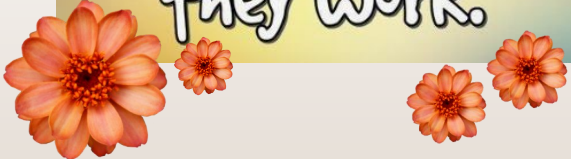

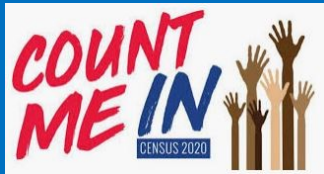




2020 CENSUS

Village Projects Update:

Wastewater Treatment Plant Project – the engineers are in the planning and design phase of this project. A recent survey was conducted once the COVID traveling restrictions were lifted. Various equipment vendors were providing demonstrations, like this screw press pictured here to improve solids handling by expediting the dewatering process. A video of the demonstration can be found on the website at www.shermanny.org under “DPW” then under “Sewer” Department.



Water Project – the engineers are in the planning and design phase of this project. The Village employees began the water main installation on Kendrick Street, as part of the in-kind services rendered toward this project. There are now 87 new meters installed and functioning.

Streets Equipment Purchase – the fork attachment for the loader is in, the loader and F-350, dump and related equipment will be on order this month through government bid. The ‘old’ loader and truck will then be traded or sent out to bid – values are holding on these trade-in items.

Stormwater Project – the Village continues to upgrade stormwater infrastructure apart from the upcoming project. This season Miller, First, and Willard Streets were completed, and Kendrick Street is being upgraded along with the water main installation.

Grant Applications – all 2020 grant applications have been suspended; we are hoping for a late September 2020 application opportunity. Otherwise, all grant applications and related projects will be pursued in 2021.
